SOME DATA ENTRY TIPS

- Are you unsure about how to record cGvHD that continues from aGvHD in ProMISe? You can find a very useful tip in the onset of cGvHD section on page 134 of the Med A-B manual located in the link following: <https://www.ebmt.org/sites/default/files/2020-12/MED-ABFormsManual.pdf>
- Do you need access to a patient record where the 1st transplant may have happened elsewhere in Europe? If yes, you will need to fill out the access request form on this link below. [Data Access Request Form](#) and send it to the EBMT helpdesk at registryhelpdesk@ebmt.org
- If a patient had multiple treatments (e.g., HSCT Auto, HSCT Allo, CAR-T) and these took place at different centres they must all be registered together in a single record held in ProMISe and allocated just one CIC. The CIC will be drawn from the 1st treatment centre, so their record needs to be created first. In the event where the treatment that took place at your centre is a subsequent one, you will be given access to the pre-existing record. Please contact us to help ensure the record has been created and that access is given to your centre to update the subsequent treatment/s.

FAILED DONATIONS PROFORMA

Please continue to send your proforma for all related donations and failed ones to our generic email address. Data Collection is ongoing till the 31st of March 2021.

Global Registration Identifier for Donors (GRID) is now being used in the UK and Europe wide. EBMT is still working on making the field for this information available on ProMISe for this information.
